The NT Dance Company is an Indigenous owned not-for-profit organisation registered with the Australian Charities & Not-for-profits Commission (ACNC) and the Register of Cultural Organisations (RoCO). The Company has deductible gift recipient status (DGR) and is eligible to receive tax deductible donations. The Company is proudly Artist in Residence at the Darwin Entertainment Centre (DEC). DEC has provided generous in-kind support to the Company enabling the production and presentation of our work both in Darwin and on the National stage.

THE OPPORTUNITY

The NT Dance Company has been funded by the NT Department of Tourism & Culture's Strategic Initiatives Program to deliver a 12 month pilot program of business development that includes the employment of a General Manager (20 hrs/week) to drive the Company forward. The Company requires a dynamic and effective general manager who is a self-starter capable of taking the organisation through to the next level of resourcing, developing the Company's Artistic Program and building on the Company's foundation of artistic and business achievements thus far.

Reporting to the NT Dance Company Board of Directors, this important position has responsibility for marketing and promotion, business development, funding and resources, corporate governance, human resource development and the administration of business systems, policies and procedures.

The successful applicant will be self-motivated and have highly developed skills in networking, marketing, communication, organisation, report and grant funding submission writing, financial management and corporate governance. Indigenous Australians are encouraged to apply.

Demonstrated experience in the Performing Arts Industry and/or Tertiary Qualifications in any of the following disciplines will be highly regarded: Arts, Law, Marketing, Human Resources, Business or Accounting.

The successful applicant will be based in Darwin, NT and be prepared to work an average of 20 hours/week (flexible hours and days as required) over the 12 month pilot period. Remuneration is for 20hrs/week prorata based on an annual salary package in excess of \$80,000 base salary plus superannuation depending on experience & qualifications.
